IMB People Group Spotlight: The Serbs of Serbia

Among the nearly 7 million Serbs in Serbia, less than 7,000 are born-again believers. Although Serbia is an Orthodox nation, most Serbs understand the church to be part of their heritage rather than related to a personal relationship with Jesus. Amid last year's COVID-19 lockdowns, a team of sent-out ones and local Serbs rallied together to reach Serbia in a new way. Thanks to a social media platform, the message of Jesus has reached 18.5 million screens in a culturally sensitive, yet powerful, way. Sixty-six Serbs have given their lives to Christ, and 962 have received a copy of God's Word. God always makes a way to get His message to His
